2002

- Decision taken in principle to develop a new head office in Bendigo
- Grant Samuel appointed as property advisers

2003

- Decision made to locate the new building adjacent to Fountain Court
- Purchased properties in Bath Lane to make room for construction of the new building
- Appointed Gallagher Jeffs as project manager
- Appointed Bligh Voller Nield and Gray Puksand as architects

2005

- Probuild appointed as builders
- Hill's Bazaar and Kell Pell buildings demolished
- Construction commenced

2004

- Plans for The Bendigo Centre finalised
- Planning approval obtained
